At COSI, you'll find amazing sights and sounds. As you explore today, pay attention to the things that you see and the sounds that you hear. ENERGY is needed to make all of these things happen, so try to find different ways that energy is being used.

Chaperones: Use this Scavenger Hunt to help your students explore COSI.




Ocean is full of lights, colors, and sounds. What is the LOUDEST sound you hear in Ocean? What is the QUIETEST SOUND?

Ocean can be dark at times. Find the DARKEST spot in Ocean. Find the BRIGHTEST spot in Ocean. Point to where the bright light is coming from?

Go inside one of the submarines. What would it be like to spend all day in there? Could you eat? Drink? Sleep? Go to the bathroom?

In the Weather Center, find the temperature of the air outside. What is it?





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Find the laser table. What do the different objects on the table do to the light?

Look at the exhibits all around Gadgets. How many different kinds of light can you find?



Find some things in 1898 that use electricity to make them work. What are they? How about in 1962? Are there more or less?

There are exhibits in this area that make sound. Pick three sounds and decide what is causing them.
